The Saint John Police have arrested two suspects in relation to a theft of motor vehicle investigation.

It is reported that:

On Wednesday, April 24, 2024, at approximately 10:31 p.m., police responded to the 100-block of Adelaide Street, in relation to a vehicle theft that had just taken place. The owner reported that she had left her vehicle parked in front of her residence while she quickly went inside to check on something. When she came back out her vehicle was taken along with her small dog which was in the back seat.

Multiple members of the Saint John Police Patrol Services Division responded and began searching for the vehicle. It was located a few hours later in the area of Main Street West. A 42-year-old man and a 20-year-old woman were found in the vehicle and taken into custody without incident.

The woman was later released from custody to appear in court on July 09, 2024. The man was released from custody with no charges.

The vehicle and dog were both safely turned back over to their owner.
