On Tuesday, November 11, 2025, at approximately 11:07 p.m., the Saint John Police responded to several calls of shots fired in the area of St. James Street in Saint John.

Officers responded and located an unconscious 42-year-old male who had sustained a serious injury in the 182-block of St. James Street. Additional emergency responders attended to assist, and the victim was transported to hospital. Subsequently, the victim was pronounced deceased.

This is an active and ongoing investigation. At this time in the investigation, police believe this to be an isolated incident. No arrests have been made.

Saint John Police Forensic Identification Services and the Major Crime Unit in cooperation with the Coroner's Office continue to investigate. Police are requesting the public in the area to check their video footage to see if they have captured anyone on their security cameras.

The Saint John Police send our condolences to the family and friends of the deceased during this most difficult time.
