The above-mentioned statistics do not include the statistics from the Slow Down Move Over campaign which ran from April 29th to May 2nd. The QRT was the driving force behind the campaign which resulted in the following:

- 58 traffic stops
- 44 tickets issued (only two tickets for slow down move over violations all other tickets were the result of the initial stop)
- 14 warnings
